- Canned soups

Here are some examples of acceptable high demand personal hygiene products:

- Deodorant
- Soap and shampoo
- Shaving products
- Toothbrushes, toothpaste and mouthwash
- Q-tips
- Diapers
- Sanitary pads

Here are some examples of acceptable high demand clothing items:

- Gently used Men's, Women's & Children's clothing and shoes
- Men's, Women's & Children's Jackets (Light to heavy weight)
- T-Shirts - sizes L, XL and XXL
- Blue jeans - all sizes
- Shorts - all sizes
- Dress pants/khakis - all sizes
- Sneakers - all sizes
- Socks - white tube & dress
- Polo and casual short-sleeve shirts - sizes L, XL and XXL
- New men's briefs and boxers - sizes 34 to 40
- Casual clothes for women: slacks, jeans, shorts, Capri's, skirts, sandals, sneakers, easy-care tops and any other spring/summer clothing, especially sizes 12 to 18.
- New women's underwear - sizes 5 to 9
- All sizes and types of clothing for children and babies
- New underwear - all sizes for boys and girls
